The child as in Anastasia's series of Ordinary Terrible Things is never defined as male or female.This is not a "Where does babies come from" book. The book deals with a child's curiosity about something grown ups talk about but a child is not suppose to know about. And of course a child just naturally thinks that if it is something he is not suppose to know about then it must be bad.In the book you follow the child though the different ways there are of discovering sex, not all very reliable or safe.Then the child decides the best person to ask was his Grandma.To me, Anastasia 's choice in using the Grandma as the child's source for answers brought the whole question of sex full circle.The Grandma had to face her old beliefs taught to her by her parents and society in order to not pass this misguided belief on to her grandchild.Children are innocent and curious. as Grandma reminds readers that sex is not marriage or reproduction, and doesn't look the same for everyone.
